This path includes Potsdam, Malone,
Plattsburgh, Lake Placid, Tupper Lake, Keene,
Indian Lake, Inlet, Old Forge, Newcomb, Port
Henry, and Schroon Lake, making these
communities prime locations for witnessing the
eclipse in its entirety.

Chapter 3: Eclipse Safety Tips

Eye Protection

The only safe way to look directly at the sun during a solar eclipse is through special-purpose solar filters, such as "eclipse glasses" or handheld solar viewers. These must comply with the ISO 12312-2 international standard. Remember, regular sunglasses, even very dark ones, are not safe for looking at the sun.

Proper Use of Eclipse Glasses

It is crucial to wear your eclipse glasses for the entire duration of the eclipse. However, during the brief phase of totality, when the sun is completely covered, you can safely view the eclipse without glasses. As soon as the sun begins to reappear, immediately use your eclipse glasses again.

Indirect Viewing Methods:

If you don't have eclipse glasses, you can use a pinhole projector. This allows you to project the sun's image onto the ground or a piece of paper to safely observe the phases of the eclipse indirectly.

Sun Exposure Precautions:

Considering that you might be outside watching the eclipse for an extended period, don't forget to use sunscreen and wear protective clothing and hats.

Hiking Considerations:


While mountain hiking might seem like a great way to view the solar eclipse, it's not recommended to hike the Adirondack High Peaks or trails above 3,000 feet during this period. April marks the spring mud season in the Adirondacks, and high elevation trails may be hazardous due to slushy snow, mud, and potential flooding. The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation advises against hiking on these trails during this time. For a safer experience, opt for lower elevation trails with open views, such as our Adirondack Fragrance Farm, or the Heaven Hill Farm Trail in Lake Placid for non-local residents.

TIMELINE OF THE

ECLIPSE

The duration of the eclipse varies based on your location within the path of totality.

In New York's Adirondacks, the total solar eclipse will follow this approximate timeline:



This means the eclipse will last from a few seconds to a maximum of 4 minutes and 28 seconds, offering a range of experiences depending on where you are in the Adirondacks.


